



For Approval 2012/2013 Transmission Loss Adjustment Factors (TLAFs) Accompanying Note

Background

The System Operators published a "For Approval" set of TLAFs on September 12th. This set was similar to that consulted on in August apart from one change: the December night values were compressed rather than being erroneously uncompressed in the August set. The SOs are now seeking approval of the set which were published on September 12th.

Additional Responses

In addition to the two responses to the TLAF consultations in July and August, PPB also sent through comments. The table below contains an update on the PPB comments (Query 5) in addition to the comments received earlier. The SOs have responded to each party individually at this point, but also have committed and will now deliver a methodology paper that explains the TLAF calculation process.
