

SONI Transmission Development Plan Northern Ireland (TDPNI) 2023-2032

Adoption Procedure

SONI is the electricity transmission system operator for Northern Ireland and is responsible for the preparation and adoption of the Transmission Development Plan for Northern Ireland (TDPNI) 2023-2032.

Our role is to operate the transmission system every minute of every day to ensure electricity can flow from where it is generated to where it is needed at the lowest price possible for the Northern Ireland consumer.

The **Transmission Development Plan Northern Ireland (TDPNI) 2023-2032** is the blueprint for the asset replacement and development of the transmission network and interconnection over the next ten years. This ten-year plan presents projects that are expected to meet the operational needs of the transmission network. The plan also outlines the future needs that may drive future potential projects.

The TDPNI document has now been published and was adopted on the **22nd January 2025**. The final document along with all associated environmental reports (SEA Statement, SEA Environmental Report and Habitats Regulations Assessment Report) are available to view at the following locations:
